Categories and target sentences.

## Mood:

Mrs. Wilson is an angry woman.

Bill is a happy man on his birthday.

The sad girl is crying.

The lonely student is homesick.

A bored boy kicks a can.

### Feeling:

The hungry (greedy) boy is always eating.  
He wants a drink because he's hot.  
He is feeling tired after his run.  
The sleepy girl is going to bed.  
The sick girl has a fever.

### Size:

Tom has a very big dog.  
A little woman is in a big pumpkin.  
It's too small, you need a large shirt.  
The basketball player is very tall.  
The short singer is a rock star.

### Shape:

It's a small, round table.  
It's a big wall clock.  
Those are very high mountains.  
Those are low green hills.  
It's a long straight road.

### Summer:



### ADJECTIVE SWITCHIT RULES

1. Deal 7 cards to each player.
2. Place the pack facedown and turn over the top card.
3. The 1st player plays a card matching the color or category (key word) and completes the sentence using an adjective which matches the category.
4. A special Switchit card changes the color of the next card to be played.
5. If a player cannot play, then a card is taken from the pack.
6. The object of the game is to get rid of all your cards.
7. Remove pack after a winner is found and continue playing.
