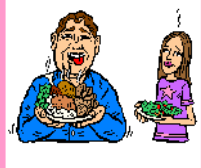

## Adverbs of Frequency Rules

1. Deal 7 cards to each player.
2. Place the pack facedown and turn over the top card.
3. The 1st player answers the question using the target adverb, plays a card that matches the color or key word of the card in play and asks the next question.
4. A special switchit card changes the color or key word of the card to be played.
5. A player who cannot play, takes a card from the pack.
6. The object of the game is to get rid of all your cards.
7. Remove pack after a winner is found and continue playing.
