

Get Some Food

Apple Family: apples, apple pears, pears and quinces.

Berries: blueberries, raspberries, red currants and strawberries.

Beverages: iced coffee, fruit juice, tea and tonic water.

Bread: French bread, melon bread, sandwiches and sliced bread.

Cabbage Family: broccoli, Brussels sprouts, cabbages and cauliflowers.

Citrus Fruit: grapefruits, lemons, limes and oranges.

Cucumber Family: cucumbers, gourds, melons and pumpkins.

Leafy Greens: lettuces, moroheiya, mustard leaves and spinach.

Legumes: beans, peas, peanuts and soybeans.

Nuts: almonds, cashew nuts, chestnuts and walnuts.

Onion Family: garlic, leaks, onions and spring onions.

Pasta: bowtie pasta, macaroni, pasta sauce and spaghetti.

Root Vegetables: carrots, potatoes, radishes and potatoes.

Seasoning: pepper, salt, soy sauce and tomato ketchup.

Shoot or Stalk: asparagus, bamboo shoots, celery and rhubarb.

Snacks: fruit tart, hotcakes, popcorn and pudding.

Soups: corn soup, egg drop soup, minestrone soup and miso soup.

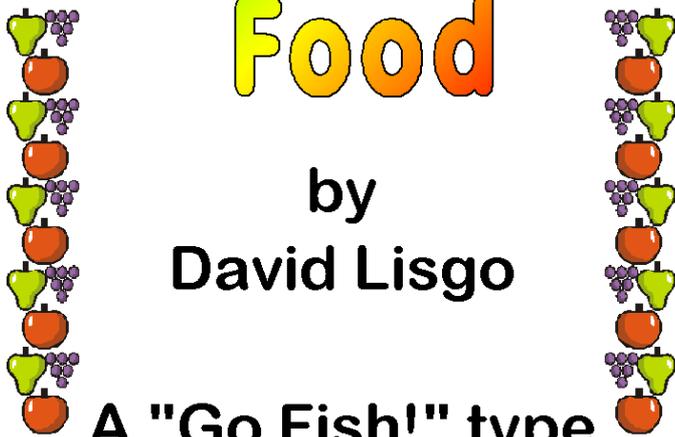
Spreads: honey, marmalade, peanut butter and strawberry jam.

Stone Fruit: apricots, cherries, peaches and plums.

Tomato Group: bell peppers, chili peppers, eggplants and tomatoes.

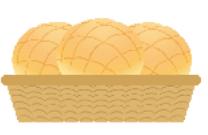

GET SOME FOOD RULES

Shuffle & deal 7 cards each, place pack face down. Players lay any pairs face up on the table saying, for e.g., "I have some lemons and limes, then the game begins. The 1st player lays a card on the table and says "I have some plums. Jun, do you have any ("some" when the card is open on the table) peaches?" "Yes, I do. Here you are." (1st player) "Plums and peaches are stone fruit" or "No, I don't. Get some food!" and the player takes the top card from the pack and play passes to the next player. When a player plays out all her cards play continues until it's her turn again and the game now ends. Any unplayed cards count as minus points.

GET SOME FOOD RULES (Expanded)

Shuffle and deal seven cards to each player and lay the pack face down in the center. Players lay any pair of cards, belonging to the same family group, face up on the table and form a sentence connecting the two cards. Here are some examples of possible sentences (the possibilities are endless):

Apple pears look like apples. I like blueberries and I like strawberries. I don't like iced coffee, but I do like tea. I have never eaten melon bread sandwiches.

The first player (Carla) lays a card face up on the table and says "I have some plums. Jun, do you have any apricots?" Who then answers either "Yes, I do. (Yes, I have some apricots.) Here you are." The receiving player lays the card and forms a sentence linking the two cards "Plums and peaches are stone fruit." or "No, I don't. (Sorry, I don't have any apricots) Get some food!" Jun then takes the top card from the pack, who has a chance to make a pair with this new card before play passes to the next player. The "plums" card remains face up on the table and any future player asking for the card should ask "Carla, do you have some plums?" When a player plays out all her cards play continues until it's her turn again, she can choose to remain in the game by taking a card from the pack or she can take the pack out of play and other players continue playing out all possibilities. Any unplayed cards can count as minus points.
