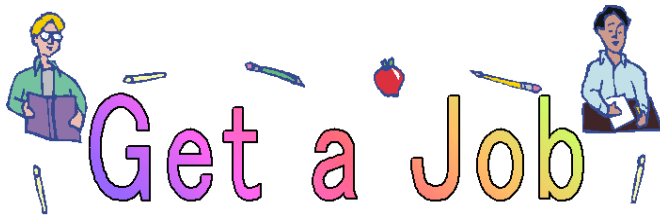

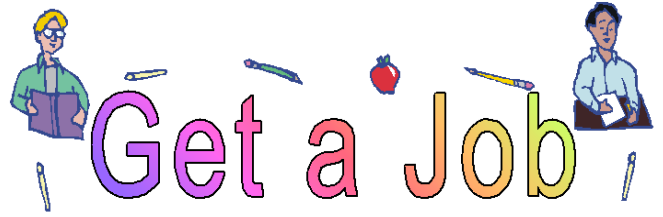

GET A JOB INSTRUCTIONS

1. Shuffle & deal 7 cards each, place pack face down. Players lay any pairs face up saying for example "He's a vet. She's a vet. They are vets."
2. The first player lays a card and says "I'm a cook. Jun, are you a cook?" "Yes, I am. Here you are." Then as in '1.'
3. Or "No, I'm not. Get a job!" (from the pack)." Note: the cook card stays on the table, then play passes to the next player.
3. When a player has no more cards in his hand, then play continues until it's his turn again. The game now ends. To extend the game the finished player can take a bonus card from the pack when it's his turn again. Cards on the table can be counted as points and cards in your hand as negative points should it be so desired.
