





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In Person

Board Game Rules

How to play the game

Use dice, two counters and "In Person" cards and board. Split the pack in two and place the cards face down in the large pink and green rectangles. Players take turns to throw a dice and move the (rearmost) counter forward by the number shown. If the counter lands on a green or pink square take a card from the green or pink rectangle, a green and pink square gets a card from each rectangle.

Here are two possibilities for one card: "We study English on Mondays."

It: (My dog) doesn't study English on Mondays.

It: (My dog) never studies English.

He/She: Makoto/Michiko studies English on Mondays.

He/She: Makoto/Michiko sometimes study English on Mondays.

You (ask classmate): Do you study English on Mondays?

You (ask classmate): Do you often study English on Mondays?

They: Bill and Ted study English on Mondays.

They: Bill and Ted often study English on Monday evening.

We: We usually study English on Monday evening.

We: We don't study English on Mondays.

I: I don't study English on Mondays, I study English on Thursday.

I: I always study English on Mondays and Fridays.

If a player lands on a dice square they roll again and pick up a card. If a player lands on a 'fishing' or 'bee' square they roll again and move back and pick up a card.

Variations:

1. No dice game. Each student has a counter and moves forward according to the number of words spoken correctly and consecutively.

Examples. She: **She doesn't English study.** (2 points) I: **I always study English on Monday evenings because I plan to go on a trip to Australia this summer.** (19 points) As you can see the teacher can also play, but usually against the whole class.

2. In Writing. Use just one dice and one counter and every student writes a sentence for each card in play. Sentences can be compared at the end of the game.
