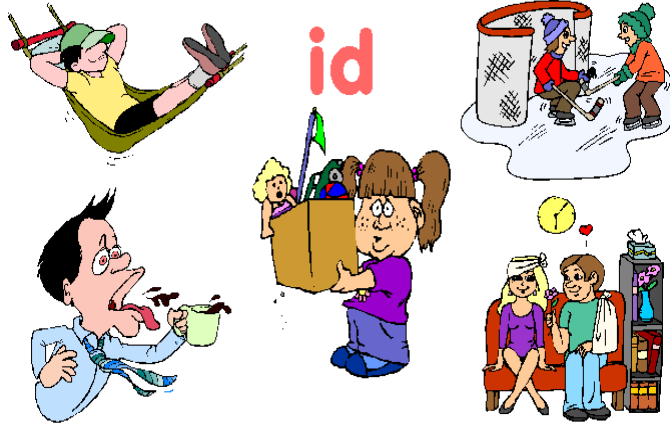

Past Regular

1. Shuffle & deal 7 cards each, place pack face down. Players lay any pairs face up saying for example "She played tennis. They played soccer."

2. 1st player lays a card and says "I used a computer. Jun, what did you use?" "I used a hammer. Here you are." Then as in '1.'

3. Or "I didn't use anything. Take a card."
Note: the "use" card stays on the table, then play passes to the next player.

3. When a player has no more cards in his hand, then play continues until it's his turn again. The game now ends. To extend the game the finished player can take a bonus card from the pack when it's his turn again. Cards on the table can be counted as points and cards in your hand as negative points should it be so desired.
Note: packs can be mixed easily.
