





# Switchaword

Switchaword 1 is a basic question and answer Switchit game which will help your students ask and answer questions smoothly and effortlessly as they play the game.

Switchaword 2 is mostly a statement and response game which focuses on the present perfect using 'already', 'for', 'just', 'never', 'since' and 'yet'. You can challenge your students to make their own responses to the statements and questions after this game becomes too easy for them.

70 cards in each pack at 1,200 yen per pack.



### WH SWITCHAWORD P1 RULES

1. Deal 7 cards to each player.
2. Place the pack facedown and turn over the top card.
3. The 1st player answers the question, plays a card and asks the next player the question, which must match the color or key word of the previous card.
4. A special switchit card changes the color or key word of the card to be played.
5. When a player cannot play, then a card from the pack.
6. The object of the game is to get rid of all your cards.
7. Remove pack after a winner is found and continue playing.

### SWITCHAWORD 2 RULES

1. Deal 7 cards to each player.
2. Place the pack facedown and turn over the top card.
3. The 1st player responds to the card, plays a card that matches the color or key word, then asks or comments on the card. 2nd player responds and continues.
4. A special switchit card changes the color or key word of the card to be played.
5. When a player cannot play, a card is taken from the pack.
6. The object of the game is to get rid of all your cards.
7. Remove pack after a winner is found and continue playing.
